5-102.13B	<p>Water analysis showed coliform bacteria was present, making the water bacterially unsafe for drinking. Please use bottled water for drinking and provide hand sanitizer at the handwashing sink. Dishes may continue to be cleaned with the water as long as sanitizer is used. This is in effect until the a water sample analysis shows the water is bacterially safe to drink. Please shock the well by adding regular, unscented household bleach, opening all taps until chlorine is detected, close taps and allow to sit a minimum of 8 hours. Then open all taps and allow to run until chlorine is no longer detected. Contact this office when the well is shocked to schedule the collection of a water sample 5 to 7 days after the shock treatment.</p>	to be scheduled
