THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS WERE OBSERVED AND MUST BE CORRECTED:

I conducted a site visit to this store after learning that it was closed on April 30 due to flooding. Upon arrival, I met with Aleisha Gleas and manager Amanda Cox who confirmed that the floor was flooded from water coming up through the floor drains in the kitchen and bathroom. Flood waters covered the floors in the kitchen, storage, and somewhat into retail portion of the store.

During this visit, Ms. Gleas and Ms. Cox provided the following information:

At approximately 3:45 am on April 30, the donut maker employee contacted the manager to report that water was coming into the store from the drains. Ms. Gleas arrived at the store at 4:45 am and found approximately 1.5 inches of water at the deepest in the bathroom. Water was standing in the bathroom, office, kitchen, and about halfway down in front of the wall coolers. Water did not get into the walk-in cooler.

The store was not opened until approximately 7:00 am after the water was vacuumed and the floor and equipment cleaned. After the rain began again, water again backed up and the store was closed about 9:00 am and remained closed until approximately 4:00 pm. Workers remained on site and squeegeed, mopped, and cleaned. The water was removed and everything was cleaned with detergent and bleach.

During this visit, the following observations were made: The floor and equipment were dry. No water stains were observed on any packaging, and no debris was observed on any packaging, floor, or equipment with the exception of soda stored on the floor beneath the 3-vat sink. According to Ms. Cox, this soda is outdated and is to be returned. Please discard outer packaging on the case of Mountain Dew, and clean the soda containers before returning.

NOTE: please contact this office if there is ever a requirement for closing: sewage backup, roof leak, or other factor that poses an imminent health threat to the public.

No further action is required at this time.
