Food Establishment Policy for Using Time as
a Public Health Control**

Time as a public health control as specified under 3-501.19 of the Missouri Food Code will be exclusively used in this food establishment rather than temperature with respect to the following potentially hazardous foods:

Milk offered at the breakfast bar.

Hard boiled eggs at the breakfast bar.

4 hour cold/hot hold

The above potentially hazardous foods **shall be 41°F lower or 135°F or greater** when removed from temperature control and **shall be marked to indicate the time that is 4 hours** from the point in time removed from temperature control.

The above potentially hazardous foods **shall be discarded within 4 hours** from the point in time removed from temperature control.

The above potentially hazardous foods in **unmarked containers or packages marked to exceed a 4 hour limit shall be discarded.**

6 hour cold hold

If the above food is held for 6 hours (**cold holding only**) as the maximum time as temperature control the following rules shall be followed:

The food shall have an initial temperature of 41°F or less when removed from temperature control and may not exceed 70°F within the 6 hours.

The food shall be monitored to ensure the warmest portion of the food does not exceed 70°F, unless an ambient air temperature is maintained to ensure that the food does not exceed 70°F.


The food shall be marked to indicate the time that is 6 hours from the point in time removed from temperature control.

The food shall be discarded if the temperature of the food, **at any time**, exceeds 70°F during the 6 hour time period. Food in unmarked containers or packages shall be discarded.

These written procedures will be maintained in the above food establishment and made available to the regulatory authority upon request. It is recommended that a temperature log be developed if 6 hour time as temperature control is used.
