Social Distancing	Steps should be taken to maintain social distancing between household units.
Procedures	Adjustments should be made to mitigate risks of contracting and spreading COVID-19: <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Consider limiting attendance to allow for distancing of six feet between individuals and family units in all directions.○ Stagger times if multiple events are scheduled.○ Post signs everywhere which indicate the recommendation for social distancing and which encourage frequent handwashing, the use of hand sanitizers, and the wearing of face masks.○ Assign staff to frequently and regularly disinfect high-touch surfaces and common use areas (counter surfaces, door knobs, restroom surfaces, etc.)○ Mark the areas where people wait in line (bathrooms, ticketing, concessions, etc.) in six-foot increments to assist patrons in distancing.○ Mark one-way walkways to provide distancing between people moving in opposite directions.○ Require staff to wear facemasks and gloves when appropriate.○ Provide hand sanitizer throughout the venue.○ Provide information on social media on how your event will mitigate the transmittance of Covid-19 among attendees.○ Encourage all performers and crew to adhere to social distancing and recommendations for wearing facemasks while in public.
PPE Needs	Consider facemasks and gloves for all staff.
