	I met with the owner of Osaki Express, Aurelio Guingab, to discuss the opening of a commissary area in the building at 1011 E. Karsch Blvd. in Farmington. Mr. Guingab's stated intent is to use the front of the area as a temporary commissary and prep area while he renovates the rest of the building into a sit-down restaurant. Mr. Guingab still intends to serve food from the mobile unit parked in front of the building. My observations are as follows:  1. A wooden counter has been built in the front of the facility. It is unpainted and unsealed. Paint or seal the wood.  2. A hand wash sink is present in the front of the facility, in the back of the facility, and in the restrooms. Please provide soap and paper towels at the sinks.  3. Wooden cabinets have been installed below the soda fountain. The cabinets are not painted or sealed. Paint or seal the cabinets.  4. The facility appears to be provided with adequate plumbing throughout.  5. No food equipment was present at the time of this inspection.  No priority violations were observed during this inspection.  The facility is approved to open.
